Dear friends,

Today I am going to a graduation ceremony, one of a number of ceremonies taking place this week.

I'm going to today's ceremony largely because I have had the privilege of knowing for the past 4 years a remarkable young man who will graduate today with a first class degree. I keep meeting young people in my work as chaplain who amaze and inspire me with their levels of self-awareness, maturity, courage and tenacity in the face of enormous challenges; intellectual, physical, emotional, and relational. Many are wise beyond their years, often because of painful experience, past or recent.

My last act of the undergraduate academic year two weeks ago was to lead with colleagues, students and staff a memorial service for a student who lost a long and courageous battle with cancer just days before the end of his undergraduate life. His story, the way his friends told it, and the way they went about arranging his remembering with us will stay with me for a long time, and not for the first time in my five years here so far have I been so very aware of how rough the edges of my own life were when I was their age, and how far ahead of me so many students are at this moment in their lives. It is not difficult to be hopeful in their company.

While the government wants to use the earnings of graduates in the future as a benchmark for a university's quality and status, so much more is going on here as people explore, learn, mature, struggle, love, let go, move on and become their truest selves a little more. I wish all those who graduate this week well.

I give thanks for the many wonderful people who inhabit my life as chaplain, even and especially those who have helped me know that I am still not the finished article either, and who help me know how to choose wisely my path through today each day, and the manner of my walking.
