Dear friends,

As many of you know, I am an endurance athlete, and a triathlete. Whether that makes me more or less sane is a matter of ongoing discussion.

There is a photograph in a recent magazine I subscribe to of Chrissie Wellington, a British triathlete, winning the Ironman World Championships in Hawaii for the 4<sup>th</sup> time. The photo shows Chrissie crossing the line in the middle distance, surrounded by crowds of spectators. Wonderful moment, I'm sure, for all who were there, especially Chrissie. The troubling thing about the photograph is that almost everyone in the photograph is busy taking a photograph. Thousands of arms are raised holding cameras aloft, and faces are looking upwards at tiny screens. All of these people are in fact not watching Chrissie win a historic victory in front of their eyes.

I have a new all singing, all dancing, very clever mobile phone, and found myself sitting on the university campus in a quiet and beautiful spot a few weeks back, waiting for colleagues, looking at my phone. I switched it off, put it away, and watched a robin finding nesting material beneath a tree in amongst the emerging bulbs. That moment profoundly marked that day of my life in ways that are hard to describe.

Having information about something is not the same as taking part in it, just as taking a picture of something is not the same as taking part in the moment being photographed. Information is easier than ever before to access. Cameras are ubiquitous, and it has become necessary to negotiate their place in a congregation's hands at the start of each wedding I've conducted recently.

Faith is a curious thing.

I am quite sure that its pathway is best signposted for us by the invitation of Jesus to take part in God's unfolding grace and healing for each of us, and the world.

That may or may not mean going to church or a mosque or gurdwara or synagogue. It does mean wrestling openly with good shared questions, rather than seeking privately satisfying answers.

It does mean looking, seeing, feeling, and allowing ourselves to be affected by life, which is not necessarily the same as trying to understand our experiences or capture them somehow. Words and pictures may help, but they aren't the same as the moment.
