Dear Friends,

How tempting it is to write about the EU Referendum. However, as an EU immigrant myself I may be somewhat biased in my opinion. What is more, my integration into British society has been so successful that I know it is 'not done' for vicars to talk about politics. What a shame!

Did you know that the Bible contains practical advice for immigrants? The prophet Jeremiah writes to the exiled Israelites in Babylon: 'Thus says the LORD: Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you in exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.' I take this to heart and pray for our politicians, our local businesses, our farmers, our teachers, our scientists, our doctors and nurses – everyone who contributes to the welfare of our community.

In centuries past, whenever the clergy would gather in the parish church to say prayers for the community, the church bells would sound. Those who heard the bells and didn't have the time or opportunity to join them, crossed themselves, and knew that they were prayed for and that prayers were said on their behalf. Today we don't sound the bell anymore, but I can assure you that the same prayers continue to be said day by day in the church, in the Vicarage and in many of the homes in our parish. For all I know you may contribute to their number. Every prayer counts, no matter how brief or seemingly unrefined. Prayer is simply attention – to God, yourself, and the reality of the moment.

The Archbishop of York visited Heslington Church on 20th May to dedicate and bless our new glass doors. He prayed for all of you, and gave each person in the congregation a small chain of prayer beads to continue prayers at home.
